### LOT 1510

A Spode bat printed part service, circa 1805, pattern No. 557, comprising teapot, cover and stand, sucrier and cover, slop bowl, jug, circular saucer dish, diameter 21.2cm, eight coffee cans, eleven bute shape teacups and ten saucers (faults and repairs).

Estimate: £50 - £70

### Condition Report

Teapot - minuscule nicks to spout, more easily felt than seen, knob of cover with glued repair and minor haircrack to flange of cover.

Teapot stand - crazed and stained.

Sucrier - 6cm long haircrack to base, cover missing knob and with vertical haircrack.

Slop - crazed and stained with fine vertical haircrack to rim.

Jug - In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

Plate - broken in half and riveted.

Saucers - 6 generally ok, one chipped and cracked, one crazed, two crazed with staining and faint hairlines.

Teacups - 10 generally ok with light typical wear, one crazed.

Cans - 7 generally ok with light typical wear, one stained and crazed.
