Two Charles Vyse pottery figures, both dated 1921, The Balloon Woman, height 22cm, and The Tulip Woman, height 26cm, blue painted marks to bases (faults and repairs).

Estimate: £250 - £350

Condition Report

Balloon Woman - overall fine crazing to glaze, highest pink balloon has been detached and visibly glued, tiny and indistinct nick to fringed hem of cloak on right side of body, the cloak has some minor flaking to the blue enamel which is only noticeable on very close inspection.

Tulip Woman - overall fine crazing to the glaze, just under half of the tulips in the basket have been broken away in three sizeable pieces and visibly glued back with losses, and a large horizontal section missing to the underside of this break with evidence of old restoration. Glued repair to neck with some old peeling restoration here, tiny nicks to bouquet of tulips held in other hand.
