Eight pieces of Royal Crown Derby decorated in the 1128 Japan pattern, 1913-1927, comprising a diamond shaped dish with acorn moulded handles, length 26cm, four vases, an octagonal dish, diameter 13.2cm, a small box and cover and a jar with pierced cover, together with a small group of Japan pattern Royal Crown Derby, including a miniature basket and a watering can (faults and repairs).

Estimate: £200 - £300

Condition Report

Small baluster vase approx 6.3cm high badly cracked, broken and glued.

Diamond shaped dish badly broken and glued.

Cover to one of the vases badly cracked and chipped.

Small bottle necked vase approx 8cm high with haircrack to neck.

Watering can crazed with glued handle.

Cover of miniature kettle badly broken and glued.

Miniature trefoil dish broken and glued.

Otherwise all items in the lot are in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.
