A Georgian gold, foil backed flat cut garnet and rose cut diamond brooch, circa 1800, of stylized coronet form, unmarked, weight 7.5g, width 4.6cm (three pendant drops lacking).

Estimate: £100 - £150

Condition Report

There are three drops missing from the front, only the connecting loops remain, these are probably subsequent additions in any case.

The central garnet cluster motif to the lower section of the brooch looks to be a later association. There are traces of later lead solder repair when viewed from the back.

The rose cut diamonds are all present, some have one or two inclusions. The settings of the rose cut diamonds are silver. The settings of the garnets are gold.
