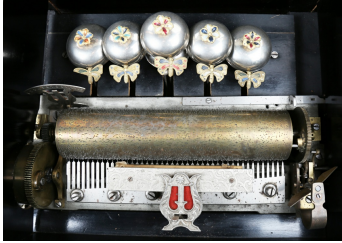

2535. Overall in good condition. One wing is broken off from one of the butterfly hammers. All teeth are present on the comb. Plays when wound although we do not think the change/repeat function is working as it should. Light age related wear. Stamped 5506.
