LOT 2016

An 18th century provincial oak dresser base with a later carved gallery back above three crossbanded drawers, height of base without gallery 76cm, width 209cm, depth 48cm.

Estimate: £300 - £500

Condition Report

2016. Small professional restoration on left drawer, lacking moulding on right drawer (approx 10cm) and centre drawer (approx 2cm). Loose escutcheon to centre drawer. Drawers do open and close, but they are quite hard work. Section of front left leg missing. Wear consistent with age and use. No key. Handles replaced. Drawer linings original but with replacement runners. Rear left leg has a spliced repair. The back is a later replacement so the base now has four non-original dowel holes. Spliced repair to top surface at rear left corner (68cm x 10cm).
