## LOT 700

A Victorian gold, silver set and diamond brooch, designed as a crescent, mounted with cushion cut diamonds graduating in size, unmarked, weight 4.3g, width 2.5cm with a later case.

Estimate: £700 - £900

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## Condition Report

In generally good condition for its age. There may have been an additional fitting at one stage evident at the back, possibly to allow the piece to be worn as a pendant, but this is now lacking.

The two ends of the crescent do not sit at the same height, whether this was intentional in the design it is unknown, the brooch hook and pin have been attached and designed to compensate for this, so possibly so.

Diamond grading is an estimation, limited by the setting and for guidance only.

Slight variation of colour to one or two, overall colour approx. H-I, clarity overall SI.

Largest diamond approx. 0.30ct. Total diamond weight approx. 1.20ct-1.30ct

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
