Edward Stanford (publisher) - Ordnance Survey of England and Wales, a part set of eighty-six 19th century engravings, the majority hand-coloured, folding in sections and backed onto linen, various sizes, within cloth covered cases 17cm x 13.5cm, with original paper labels. Note: includes nos. 1-7, 9-27, 30-31, 33-35, 43-48, 50-56, 59-66, 70-75, 77-83, 86-89, 92-98 and 101-108, which includes the counties of Kent, Sussex, Hampshire, Wiltshire, Oxfordshire and Yorkshire.

Condition Report

122 - 1 - Some age toning and foxing. Slightly affected by damp, some mould evident. Slipcase fraying at extremities. Dated 1844

2 - In relatively good condition. Minor age toning. Slipcase similarly okay. Dated 1871.

3 - Minor browning. Small ink scrawl to left hand margin. Slipcase slightly rubbed to extremities. Dated 1819.

4 - Minor stains to blank area. Ink inscription to left hand margin. Minor age toning and light soiling. Slight rubbing to slipcase, frayed to corners. Dated 1871.

5 - Some age toning. Two prominent spots of foxing near the 'E'. Pater foxing elsewhere. Ink annotations around the edge of related interest. Slipcase a little frayed and split. Dated 1813.

6 - Some age toning and light soiling. Some ink annotations to left margin. Small stain to the bottom wight section. Slipcase slightly rubbed. Dated 1877.
