A George V silver rectangular snuff box with hinged sprung front and lid, London 1911 by Goldsmiths & Silversmiths Co Ltd, length 5.4cm, and a group of other silver, comprising baluster half spiral reeded vase, Sheffield 1901 by Walker & Hall, height 8.5cm, pair of Old English pattern sauce ladles, Sheffield 1921, four-division toast rack, total weight 335.2g, and a silver mounted cut glass hip flask with detachable cup, Sheffield 1919 and 1921 by James Dixon & Sons Ltd, height 11.5cm (hinge broken).

Condition Report

317 - Snuff box is in generally good condition with typical light surface scratches and wear. Hinges are good. Good clear hallmarks to interior. Engraved initials 'C. F. B' to cover.

Toast rack - Some misshaping to divisions and handle. Typical surface scratches and wear. Good clear hallmarks.

Frill rim pot - Some misshaping to rim. Minor misshaping to footrim and typical light surface scratches and wear. Marks slightly rubbed.

Pair of sauce ladles - Good condition. Typical light surface scratches. Engraved initial. Good clear hallmarks.

Hip flask - Hinge to lid is broken. Otherwise typical surface scratches and wear to lid and cup. Small dent to corner of cup and dent to lid. Different dates (two years difference), to cup and lid.
