A collection of seven Chinese silver sycee ingots of various sizes, each with cast seal mark, lengths ranging from 2.7cm to 7.5cm, weights ranging from 22.7g to 364.3g.

Estimate: £2,000 - £3,000

Condition Report

1050. Largest ingot - length 7.4cm, height 4cm, width 4cm, weight 364.4g.

Next largest ingot - length 7.5cm, height 4.6cm, width 3.8cm, weight 200.2g.

Smaller ingot - length 4.5cm, height 2.8cm, width 2.4cm, weight 78.9g.

Oval ingot - length 2.7cm, height 1.3cm, width 2.2cm, weight 34.5g.

Two small ingots - 1) length 2.9cm, height 1.1cm, width 1.3cm, weight 22.2g. 2) length 2.8cm, height 1.1cm, width 1.3cm, weight 22.7g.

Larger rectangular ingot - length 4.7cm, depth 2.1cm, width 3.5cm, weight 203.1g.

All ingots in generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs. Typical light surface scratches and wear, but nothing of any real significance.
