A Chinese turquoise, aubergine and yellow enamelled biscuit porcelain water pot, mark of Qianlong but probably late Qing dynasty, of globular form, moulded in relief with a dragon amidst vapours confronting an articulated pearl, moulded seal mark to base, height 7.4cm, together with a Chinese famille rose turquoise ground circular bowl, diameter 11.2cm.

Estimate: £60 - £100

Condition Report

1057. Water pot - generally good condition, but with some minor nicks to spine relief of the dragon, otherwise no significant damage or repairs.

Bowl - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs. Typical light surface scratches and wear to glaze.
