A small group of Chinese blue and white porcelain, late 19th century and later, including a baluster vase, painted with prunus, height 18.5cm, two similarly decorated ginger jars and a cover and two cylinder vases, heights 20cm and 20.6cm (some faults).

Estimate: £50 - £100

Condition Report

1062. Baluster vase - 'U' shaped section of rim broken out and reglued (approx 4cm x 2.3cm) with chips around the break lines. Otherwise ok.

2 ginger jars - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs.

Crackled cylinder vase - chips to rim, hairline cracks to rim and repaired section (7.3cm x 13cm).

Other cylinder vase - chip to rim and repaired broken out 'U' shaped section (approx 4.5cm x 9.5cm).
