A Chinese hardwood circular stand, late Qing dynasty, the top carved and pierced with a circular panel of crane beneath pine, the apron carved and pierced with further bird and flower panels within prunus borders, diameter 16.5cm, together with two other Chinese hardwood circular stands with carved and pierced aprons, diameters 15.5cm and 18.2cm. Provenance: the property of a West Sussex private collector.

Condition Report

1150. Carved and pierced stand - in very good condition with finely carved panel and apron. No significant damage or repairs. Typical light surface wear and minor nicks. Nice patina.

Larger stand - generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs. Minor nicks and typical light wear.

Smaller stand - generally good condition with finely carved apron. No significant damage or repairs. Typical minor nicks and light wear.
