An Edwardian gold and seed pearl oval hinged bangle, the front with a twin open entwined heart motif, on a snap clasp, unmarked, weight 4.3g, inside width 5.6cm, and a gold oval hinged bangle, the front in a buckle and strap design, with engraved foliate decoration, on a snap clasp, indistinct mark, weight 7.3g, inside width 5.7cm.

Estimate: £150 - £200

Condition Report

Seed pearl heart gold bangle - the bangle is unmarked, the colour would suggest that it is likely 9ct gold, but this is untested.

The bangle is slightly misshaped at the back, making it quite difficult to fasten the clasp. The pearls are in good condition, with an attractive lustre.

Buckle and strap gold bangle - the bangle has a British hallmark, however it is so rubbed that it is unreadable. The colour of the gold again would suggest 9ct gold, but this is untested.

A slightly untidy join where the buckle joins the bangle, it is also slightly wonky, it may be that it has been repaired sometime in the past.

The bangle has a couple of small dents here and there. The clasp is in good order.

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
