A silver and banded grey agate bracelet, circa 1900, probably Scottish, the centre in a shaped oval openwork design between tapered panel shaped sides, on a snap clasp, unmarked, weight 44.7g, length 17cm.

Condition Report

There are one or two tiny nicks to the outer edges of the grey agates, these were all possibly present when the piece was first manufactured due to their location. The majority only really noticeable when looking under a 10x loupe.

The clasp is in good working order. The engraved decoration all looks to be in generally good order.

Some minor tarnishing.

Overall in generally good condition.

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
