Condition Report

49. Previously cleaned and restored. UV examination highlights that the lettering appears to be emboldened. Some splits around edge of canvas where it folds over stretcher. Varnish has dulled and is a little uneven. Surface is also a little uneven, with pitting and protrusions. Frame ok but with some chips and scuffs, and loss of composition to extremities.
