Condition Report

33. Relined, cleaned and restored. UV examination highlights overpainting throughout, including to the mother's face, the child's leg, the hands, and elsewhere. Some minor paint separation and craquelure. Varnish has dulled and is inconsistent, particularly around the areas of restoration. Some subsequent surface dirt. Frame with old restoration, particularly to corners, and these areas repainted 'gilt'.
