An Edwardian gold and diamond six stone bar brooch, claw set with a row of cushion cut diamonds graduating in size to the centre, fitted with a safety chain, unmarked, weight 4g, total diamond weight approx 0.80-0.90ct, width 4.8cm, with an associated case.

Estimate: £200 - £250

Condition Report

Two of the diamonds on one far side both have two fairly large cleavage chips to the sides. The other diamonds have a few nicks/nibbles to the girdles. One has a few nibbles to the table facet edges. The pin fitting is in working order. All the claws are present, with only very minor wear.

Estimation of diamond gradings are for guidance only and limited by the settings.

The diamonds generally have minimal inclusions. The three stones without cleavage chips, clarity approx VS2-SI1. Overall colour approx I/J.

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
