A platinum and diamond ring, claw set with the principal square emerald cut diamond between baguette cut diamond two stone shoulders, detailed 'Plat', weight 3.4g, principal diamond weight approx 0.80ct, ring size approx M.

Condition Report

600. Estimation of diamond gradings are for guidance only and limited by the setting.

Central diamond - clarity VS2-SI1

There is a tiny crystal inclusion which is surface reaching to one side of the table near the facet edge, of which can be seen without a 10x loupe, though you really do have to be looking for it to see it.

Central diamond - colour G-H

The central diamond has medium blue fluorescence when placed under an ultraviolet light.

The central diamond does not appear to be cloudy or hazy in appearance.

The central diamond's symmetry appears overall to be good.

The ring has possibly been resized in the past. There is some thinning to the back of the shank and some wear to the sides where it has likely been worn against other rings. There are some areas of discolouration to the sides of the mount, which may benefit from a clean, only noticeable when viewed under a loupe.
