A late 19th century French brass cased carriage timepiece with eight day movement, the circular enameled dial with blue Arabic hour numerals within a pierced gilt fretwork surround, decorated with griffins and scrolling foliage, the doucine case with swing handle and gilt overlaid scroll panels, on turned feet, height 15.8cm, with travelling case and key, together with a brass corniche cased carriage timepiece, height 15.2cm, with travelling case and key (faults).
