A late 19th century lacquered brass four glass mantel clock with eight day movement striking on a bell, the backplate stamped with 'J. Marti' maker's mark, with mercury compensated pendulum, the two piece white enamelled dial with black Roman hour numerals and inscribed 'J. Edmonds', the case with bevelled glass panels, on bracket feet, height 30cm.

Estimate: £150 - £200

Condition Report

1265. The case is in generally good condition with only typical light surface scratches and wear. Small chip to bottom edge of glass back door panel, otherwise glass is good. Dial in good condition. Movement winds and runs for a short time but does not maintain, probably requires a service/clean to return to full working order. Striking mechanism in working order.
