An Art Deco rouge marble, onyx, slate and spelter mantel clock with eight day movement striking on a bell, the fan shaped silvered dial with black Arabic hour numerals, the fan shaped case back with rectangular plinth flanked by a pair of standing nude maidens, height 36cm.

Condition Report

1261. Generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs. Typical surface scratches and wear. Bit dusty and dirty. Minor nicks/chips to edges of slate base, marble and onyx. Underside of base is missing one of its six feet. Typical surface wear to spelter figures, both having been broken at feet and re-attached. The going train winds smoothly and the clock is currently running, but the strike train does not wind and is not working. Length/width 71.3cm, height 36.5cm, depth of base only 16.3cm, depth of clock including back of movement 20.3cm.
