A late 19th century French spelter and marble clock garniture, the clock with eight day movement striking on a bell via an outside countwheel, the enameled dial with black Arabic hour numerals and painted swags, the spelter case surmounted with an urn and flanked by seated putto, on a marble base, height 32cm, with pendulum and winding key, flanked by a pair of matching cassiolette urns and covers.

1289. The case and urns in generally good condition with no significant issues. Typical light surface scratches and wear. Marble base in good order with only minor nicks to edges. The movement winds smoothly and runs, and the striking mechanism is also working as it should, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.

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
