## LOT 1285

A George III mahogany longcase clock with eight day movement striking hours on a bell, the 12-inch brass breakarch dial with silvered strike/silent indicator to arch above a silvered chapter ring with black Roman hour numerals and outer Arabic minutes, framing a matt centre with silvered subsidiary seconds, date aperture and silvered plaque, signed 'John Thomson London', the arched hood with three brass ball finials above a pierced fretwork pediment, glazed door and brass stop fluted columns, on a panelled base and bracket feet, height 227cm, with pendulum and two brass cased weights (some faults and alterations).

Estimate: £500 - £800

## Condition Report

1285. The clock is in generally good order with typical surface wear, nicks etc commensurate with age. Hood has had a later replacement fretwork arch, missing small piece of moulding to top of side glass panel on one side, and spots to both sides of hood. Trunk door is slightly bowed and split to front panel of base. Dial and movement in generally good order with minor scratches and wear. Small hole to brass dial, just to left of the strike/silent subsidiary dial. Seatboard has split at sometime and had re-inforcements. All condition issues can be seen in the images on our website.

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
