### LOT 1263

A late Victorian Gothic Revival oak cased mantel timepiece with eight day fusee movement, the backplate signed 'Payne & Co 163 New Bond St London', the similarly signed silvered arch dial with black Roman hour numerals, the rectangular case with moulded top above a band of rosettes, on a plinth base, height 27.5cm, with pendulum, together with an oak wall bracket and a 19th century satinwood rectangular plinth with brass ball feet, width 20cm.

Estimate: £150 - £250

### Condition Report

1263 - The timepiece is in generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs. One rosette missing to side of case, minor nicks, scuffs and splits to veneer or front door and side. Movement winds smoothly and runs but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch. The satinwood plinth with typical nicks and splits to veneer and wear. Oak bracket in good order but not matching the clock.

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
