A Scottish Regency mahogany longcase clock with eight day movement striking on a bell, the 13-inch circular painted dial with black Roman hour numerals, subsidiary seconds and date dials, inscribed 'McNab Perth', the hood with mounted arch pediment above a glazed circular door, the cut cornered trunk with line inlaid decoration and arched door, on a plinth base and bracket feet, height 201cm, with pendulum and two weights.

Estimate: £200 - £400

Condition Report

1295 - Generally good condition. Typical scuffs and wear but no significant issues. Split to top left corner of trunk door.

The dial has some faint craquelure, some typical wear and a few minor marks, otherwise in good order.

Movement winds smoothly and runs but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.

Strike mechanism also in good working order.
