LOT 747

A 9ct gold pendant, designed as an apple, opening to reveal Adam and Eve, London 1961, weight 9.5g, length 2.4cm, with a gold neckchain, unmarked, weight 1.6g, length 52cm.

Estimate: £150 - £200

Condition Report

Chain is unmarked, but most likely 9ct gold. Please note that currently the end loop of the chain is too large to allow it to thread through the loop of the apple pendant, so the two pieces can currently not be worn together. The apple does close firmly with a snap. There is a fair bit of damage/loss to the enamel, particularly to Adam's skin, the green snake and to Eve's hair. There is what looks to be the remains of green enamel to the top of the apple's stalk, whether this area of the exterior would have been enamelled originally is unknown. Typical light wear to the exterior otherwise.

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
