A late Victorian 15ct gold and diamond three stone brooch of elliptical form, decorated with a ropetwist wirework surround within a beaded and scroll pierced border, Chester 1895, weight 5.1g, width 4.9cm, with a case.

Estimate: £150 - £200

Condition Report

The brooch is generally in good condition.

The hinge and pin are working well.

There are no dents and no obvious scratches to speak of.

The diamonds look secure within their settings, one under a loupe looks like it may have a chip to the girdle, but not noticeable without magnification.

There is some general variation in outline to the diamonds as they are old cut stones.

The safety chain is in good order.

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
