### Condition Report

320 - Box in generally good condition. Typical surface scratches and wear. A few minor holes worn through on the highpoints of the foliate border. Few minor nicks/dents to edges. Engraving slightly worn. Hinge is good but lid gapes ever so slightly. Good clear hallmarks.
