Condition Report

2430. Some surface dirt and age toning to paper. Minor foxing, most prominent to sash. Colours remain good but there is some signs of instability in the darkest red areas. Frame with an overall craquelure to surface and minor chips to extremities, a slightly worse chip to the bottom left corner. Clasp verso slightly loose. This work has not been examined out of the frame.
