Condition Report

1025 - Good condition with no chips, cracks or repairs. Typical minor surface scratches to glaze and minor wear to enamels and gilt. There is a 2.5cm pale vertical line below the calligraphy on the back of the vase, please note this is a glaze blemish not a hairline crack.

Wood stand weight - 50g
