A Japanese Satsuma earthenware bowl by Yabu Meizan, Meiji period, of steep-sided circular form, the exterior finely painted and gilt with radiating vertical panels of millefleurs, above a footrim with butterflies and gilt scrolls, the interior filled with butterflies, gilt signature to base, height 6.3cm, diameter 11.8cm.

Condition Report

1100. Good condition. No chips, cracks or repairs. Only very minor wear to gilt and enamels. Typical light crazing visible under magnification. Very fine painting with good vibrant enamels. Minor blemish/bruise to gilt on the rim but does not run into earthenware body. Good gilt signature to base.
