A Chinese blue and white export porcelain garden seat, Qing dynasty, probably 18th century, of barrel form, painted with Ming style lotus and leaf scrolling tendrils within stud moulded borders, the top and sides with pierced cash panels, height 46cm (cracked and rivet repaired).

Estimate: £800 - £1,200

Condition Report

1169. One side of the seat has an oval shaped crack which has been repaired with ten rivets. There is some minor chipping glaze loss along the crack, particularly at the top left of the curve. Typical surface scratches and wear to glaze which is more pronounced on the top. Otherwise the rest of the body is in sound condition.
