A pair of Chinese millefleurs ground 'medallion' porcelain bowls, late Qing/Republic period, each exterior painted with three circular grisaille landscape panels, reserved against dense famille rose enamelled flowers on a brown and gilt ground, erased mark to bases, height 6.7cm, diameter 14cm (one with tiny rim nick).

### Condition Report

1275. Bowl 1 - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs. Typical light wear to gilt and enamels. Minor surface scratches to glaze. The underside has had a mark erased, so there is a scratched area of glaze.

Bowl 2 - minor chip to rim, otherwise in good condition with no cracks or repairs. Typical light wear to gilt and enamels. Minor surface scratches to glaze. Like the other bowl, it has an erased mark to base.
