A late 19th/early 20th century gilt painted and carved Empire style armchair, the tub back moulded in relief with a Green Man mask flanked by scrolls and opposing beasts, the wing arms with term handrests above reeded legs, height 91cm, width 69cm, depth 59cm.

Condition Report

2123. The main structure of the chair is carved wood, with some of the surface ornamentation being composite - such as the wings and decor to the back. Overall surface wear and some cracks to the structure of the back. Small spliced repair to rear foot and clearly later gilt painted surface.
