A George II silver caster of girdled low-bellied form, the pierced domed cover with pierced grille and knob finial, on a domed circular foot, London 1735 by John Gamon, height 12.3cm, and a George III silver baluster caster with pierced domed cover, on a circular foot, London 1782 by William Turton, height 13.5cm, total weight 178.6g.

Condition Report

332. Girdled caster - generally good condition with typical surface scratches and wear. Few minor dents to body and slightly misshapen footrim. Dent to top of cover where finial pushed down slightly. No marks to lid. Lid fits tightly.

Baluster caster - generally ok but a bit worn. Typical surface scratches and wear. Some minor dent to body and cover. Lid fits tightly.
