Petersen & Co', height 22.5cm. Note: B. Petersen & Co were silversmiths based in Christchurch.

Condition Report

420. Egg with drilled hole to one side, as well as typical surface scratches, silver mounts are dirty, but with no significant damage. Some minor misshaping to branches and leaves, but otherwise appears to be in good order. The securing bolt through the stem is a little loose so would need tightening.
