A Norman Grant Scottish silver and enameled brooch, designed as a stylized flowerhead, Edinburgh 1972, width 3.8cm, and an Arts and Crafts style silver pendant of circular openwork form, applied with scroll and beaded decoration, mounted with a faceted orange gemstone, London 1989, width 3.8cm, total weight 28.4g.

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

Grant brooch - all the enamel is in tact, needs a clean. The clasp is in working order, if a little loose. Minimal scratching to setting.

Pendant - some very minor nicks/dents, there is no fitting as such for the piece to be worn as a pendant, and no evidence of any that might be missing.

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
