A silver cased keywind open-faced gentleman's pocket watch, the engine turned silvered dial with gilt Roman numerals and subsidiary seconds, London 1872, case diameter 5cm, with a key, together with two other silver cased keywind open-faced pocket watches, import marks London 1909 and Chester 1872, with two keys, a J.W. Benson London silver cased keyless wind open-faced pocket watch, London 1933, another keywind open-faced gentleman's pocket watch with silvered dial, two further watch keys and a base metal cased wristwatch with unsigned gilt lever movement.

Estimate: £150 - £250

Condition Report

1012. Silvered dial, London 1872 - does not run, typical surface scratches and wear to case.

Other silvered dial - does not run, case badly worn and dents. Dial with some discolouration.

J.W. Benson - does not wind or run. Otherwise case and dial in generally good condition.

Chester 1872 - does not wind or run. Dial in good condition. Case with wear and minor dents.

Remaining pocket watch - chipped dial, does not wind or run, case worn and dented.

Base metal wristwatch - winds smoothly and starts ticking, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch. Dial cracked, wear to case

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
