### LOT 1235

A 20th century lacquered brass cased carriage clock with eight day movement striking hours and half hours and repeating on a gong, the backplate inscribed 'Matthew Norman London' and numbered '1751 A', the enamelled dial with Roman hour numerals, detailed 'Matthew Norman Swiss Made', the corniche case with swing handle and bevelled glass panels, on bracket feet, height 17.6cm, with winding key and plastic case.

Estimate: £120 - £180

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### Condition Report

1235. Generally good condition with typical surface scratches and wear, as well as some pitting and spotting to the gilt lacquer case. The movement winds and adjusts smoothly and it is currently running. The striking mechanism however may need some adjustment as it strikes and repeats but not the correct amount of times.

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
