### LOT 1255

An early Victorian mahogany bracket clock, the eight day twin fusee movement striking hours on a bell with pull repeat mechanism, the 6-inch painted circular dial with black Roman hour numerals and inscribed 'Larard Clapham Road', the case with applied carved foliate scroll mouldings to the shaped arch top above a cushion base and plinth, height 32.5cm, with pendulum and winding key (later brass bezel and bevelled glass detached).

### Condition Report

1255. The clock case is in generally good condition with typical scuffs, scratches and wear, but no significant damage or repairs. The later spun brass bezel has a loose glass. Dial is slightly discoloured with some scratches and wear. The movement winds smoothly and it is currently running please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch. The strike and repeat mechanism appears to be in working order, but we think the bell is not the original as it is too small and the hammer does not reach it on the hour or repeat.
