A George III mahogany bracket clock with eight day twin fusee movement striking hours on a bell, the backplate with finely engraved foliate scrolls, the repainted arch dial with strike/silent indicator to arch above Roman hour numerals, subsidiary date dial and inscribed 'Frans Sinderby London', the case with moulded arch pediment and single pad top above a pair of brass handles and pierced fret panels to sides, on a rectangular plinth base and brass bracket feet, height 45cm, with pendulum.

Estimate: £400 - £600

Condition Report

1263. The clock has had some restoration, including a repainted dial and typical work to case. We would suggest the pad on top may be a later replacement and may have originally had the usual brass carry handle. Some veneer repairs to frame of front and back door. Some typical veneer splits. The clock winds smoothly and is currently running but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch. The strike mechanism also in working order. The clock has obviously had restoration, but the movement appears to match the case with no obvious signs of alterations. Nicely engraved backplate, supports and pendulum.
