### LOT 1111

An American Waltham Watch Co 'London, Brighton & South Coast Railway' silver cased keyless wind open-faced gentleman's pocket watch, the signed jewelled movement numbered '17924971', the enamelled dial with black Roman hour numerals and subsidiary seconds, the silver inner case detailed 'London Brighton & South Coast Railway 752', Birmingham 1912, case diameter 5.4cm, together with a base metal curb link watch chain, hung with an enamelled brass N.U.R. pendant fob and an enamelled silver Amalgamated Society of Railway Servants pendant fob (badly worn).

### Condition Report

1111. Case is worn with dents to back and sides. Glass/crystal is chipped at 7 o'clock edge. Dial appears to be in good clean condition. The watch winds but is a little clunky and the movement only ticks a couple of times before stopping. The hands adjust from the crown, and do so smoothly.

National Union of Railwaymen fob is worn with minor enamel loss.

Amalgamated Society of Railway Servants fob is badly worn with enamel loss.
