A George IV Scottish silver King's pattern sifter ladle, the handle foliate engraved above a foliate shouldered bowl pierced and engraved simulating a naturalistic pool, Glasgow 1827 by Robert Gray & Son, length 17.5cm, and a set of six George III silver Hourglass pattern tablespoons, London 1817 by Paul Storr, total weight 621g, length 22.5cm.
