A gold, silver, diamond, turquoise and pearl set pendant brooch, late 19th century, in a panel shaped design within scroll pierced borders, mounted with three rows of turquoises and six pearls, otherwise set with rose cut diamonds, unmarked, weight 20.2g, length 6.4cm.

Estimate: £400 - £600

Condition Report

In generally good condition.

One or two diamonds have chips. Two turquoise have been chipped. Pearls have an attractive lustre.

Rose cut diamonds generally draw colour.

Pin and fittings in working order.

The gold is unmarked but is likely 15ct gold or higher.

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
