A George III silver mustard of urn form with hinged lid, scroll handle, pierced sides and bright cut engraved decoration, on a circular foot, fitted with a blue glass liner, London 1784 by Robert Hennell, weight 121.3g, height 11.8cm (hinge pin missing). Provenance: purchased from J.H Bourdon-Smith in 1955.

Condition Report

415 - Generally good condition. No significant damage or repairs other than hinge pin missing. Good crisp engraving with some typical minor surface scratches and wear to engraving, slightly more pronounced on the rim of lid. Glass in good order. No erasures. Good clear hallmarks to base and part mark to lid interior.
