Condition Report

410 - These are a good quality set of four wine coasters. All four coasters in generally good clean condition with no significant damage or repairs. All hallmarks matching. Typical light surface scratches and wear, but piercing and engraving still good and crisp. Each engraved with a crest. Wood bases have typical wear to varnish and minor chips to edges. Some slight detail difference to turning in centre.
