A Victorian 15ct gold, turquoise and half-pearl ring in a panel shaped design, Birmingham 1871, weight 2.7g, ring size approx M1/2, and a 9ct gold, opal and sapphire five stone ring, weight 1.4g, ring size approx I.

Estimate: £70 - £100

Condition Report

Turquoise ring - variation of lustre to the pearls, a pair on one side are slightly subdued in lustre and are beginning to show signs of wear, one in particular is peeling. One or two turquoise have typical discoloration to green

Sapphire/opal ring - thinning to shank, hallmark partially worn, likely a later reproduction of an earlier style, 1970s

Both rings have typical light scratching/wear to the setting /shank overall.

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
