LOT 547

A gold ring, claw set with a cushion cut diamond, detailed '15ct W.Gold 18ct', weight 1.8g, ring size approx K, with a case.

Estimate: £100 - £150

Condition Report

Diamond weight approx 0.50-0.60ct.

The diamond has a couple of fairly noticeable chips below the table facet on one side.

The stone is an old cut stone but is mounted in a later setting, probably first half 20th century.

The 15ct white gold mark likely refers to the leaf shoulders (which are slightly discolored now) and claws of the ring, whilst the 18ct gold probably refers to the shank of the ring.

There is quite a lot of wear to the shank and one side of the mount has been heavily worn also.
