## LOT 546

A South African silver and tiger's eye bracelet, formed as a row of five rectangular panels, each set with an elongated oval tiger's eye, otherwise in a bar link design, on a hook shaped clasp, detailed 'STG', with original guarantee, dated '30 March 1965', and pouch, together with a silver and tiger's eye single stone ring, detailed '925', ring size approx Q1/2, total weight 102.7g.

Estimate: £100 - £150

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## Condition Report

Bracelet - the clasp looks to be the original and is in good working order.

The tiger's eyes have very minor wear to the high points if at all. Two or three are showing very minor natural fissures within the stones which appear to go against the structure, these are not surface reaching however and currently do not threaten the integrity of the stones, more of an aesthetic concern.

Ring - some slight wear to the high point of the tiger's eye.

Both items have some typical light scratching and wear to the setting.

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
